## more than you think...

## Use today's technology and get more than you think from your library.

- Catalogue use the library catalogue to check the availability of titles, place reserves, and access your account to see what you have on loan and when it's due back.
- CD-ROM resources includes a variety of magazine indexes and reference books.
- CINCH a database of local clubs, organisations and courses, available at all libraries and via the library website.
- E-books available for loan from Central City Library. Load up to 20 titles onto these book size electronic devices and enjoy at your leisure.
- E-services card a convenient way to pay for printing, photocopying or email.
- Free internet use the Public Information Terminals (PITs) to surf New Zealand's net and thousands of pre-selected overseas sites.
- Library card Use your card to borrow books and other items. You can also store money on new library cards to pay for printing, photocopying, and internet time. If you have an old card you can upgrade it at any library.
- Microfiche and microfilm use the microfiche/film readers at the Central City Library to view and copy material from newspapers and historic records.
- Pay-for internet and email gives you greater access to the web and web-based email.
- **Photocopying** available at all libraries. Colour photocopying is available at Central City and Shirley libraries.

- Premium databases includes on-line magazines, newspapers, the Oxford dictionary and encyclopaedias, plus business, science, music, art, biography and literature databases. Available at all libraries and via the library website.
- Self-issue machines issue your own books and magazines at the Central City Library and some community libraries.
- Visit our website for the library catalogue, premium databases, news and reviews, local history, kids' stuff, links to other sites, plus much much more. http://library.christchurch.org.nz

Please note: You will need a PIN to access your personal account and the premium databases via the internet. Please ask for a PIN at your local library.

## Loading money onto your library card

E-services cards have been available from the Christchurch City Libraries for over two years. People have used them to pay for a range of library services such as internet time, extended loan charges or photocopying. These cards are still available but now we can also load money onto your library membership card.

### Can I use my existing library card?

All cards issued since May this year can have money loaded onto them. If your card is older than this you will need to replace it if you want to use it as a credit card. A librarian can help with this.

#### • Will it cost me anything to do this?

No.You will only pay for the amount of credit you wish to load onto your card.

• Where can I load the money on?

Every Christchurch City library has the facilities to do this. At Central City Library you can load the money onto your card yourself (two self-loading machines are available), or ask a librarian to do it for you. At all other Christchurch City libraries you need to ask a librarian.

- How long will it take? The actual transaction only takes a few seconds.
- How much credit can I put on the card? We recommend that you limit the credit on each card to no more than \$30.
- Can I use my credit card to transfer credit onto my card? Not at this stage. You can use cash, cheque or EFT-POS at the desks. You can only use cash (New Zealand currency) in the self-loading machines.
- What happens if my card is stolen? As with any type of credit card, it is your responsibility to keep it safe. Like your current membership card, if you lose it or it is stolen, please contact us on (03) 379 6914.
- Which library services can I use my membership card to pay for?

Borrowing, internet access, printing and photocopying, extended loan charges, purchase of product or any other library service.

• Can anyone use my card?

We would prefer that only you, the owner of the card, use it.
