CATALOGUE

The library catalogue holds information on all the items we hold in the library. You can access the catalogue in our libraries or on our website http://library.christchurch.org.nz

Use the catalogue to check:

- . If we hold a particular title
- · Where it is located in the library network
- If it is available to borrow now

RESERVING ITEMS

You can reserve an item for only \$1.50. It's easy.

Simply ask a librarian or give us a call. Alternatively you can use the catalogue online to reserve it yourself and choose which library to collect it from (you will need a PIN to do this). When the item arrives, you will receive an email or letter:

INTER-LIBRARY LOANS

If the library does not have an item you want, please ask us about inter-library loan – a co-operative scheme where libraries throughout New Zealand lend items to each other. There is a charge for this service.

PAY COLLECTIONS

Most items in the library are free to borrow, however there are some exceptions. These include:

- Bestseller Collection
- · CDs, Tapes, Talking Books, Language Courses
- · CD Roms

GENERAL MEMBERSHIP

A general membership gives you access to all the services of the library. Most books are free, but you will have to pay for reserves, bestsellers, extended loan, CDs, tapes, talking books and language courses.

YOUTH MEMBERSHIP

If you are under 19, you can benefit from a youth membership.

Not only will you be able to take advantage of the general library membership privileges, but you will be able to place FREE reserves. And if you return things late, there is no charge — except for CD-ROMs and bestsellers.

There will still be charges for borrowing Adult CDs, tapes, CD-ROMs and Bestsellers.

CORPORATE MEMBERSHIP

For companies and organisations based in Christchurch, there is the option of corporate membership - giving your business access to library services for business purposes.

A single card gives your business access to high quality information services as well as books, standards, journals and videos free of charge. In addition CDs, tapes and CD-ROMs are available for a small fee. There is a four week loan period for most items and you can borrow up to 20 items at one time.

To join as a Corporate Member, you need a business in Christchurch, proof of business identity and signed authorisation from the Finance Manager or Sole Trader:

SPECIAL MEMBERSHIP

If you are a Christchurch resident or ratepayer and have a condition that restricts your use of the library, you may be able to join as a special member.

As a special member you will be able to:

- Borrow books, magazines, talking books, videos, tapes and CDs free of charge
- · Borrow most items for up to six weeks
- · Reserve items free of charge
- · Return items late without being charged

You will still have to pay to borrow adult CD-ROMs and items from the Bestseller Collection. A medical certificate, letter from your specialist or other verification of your condition may be required.

NON-CITY MEMBERSHIP

If you live out of town or are visiting Christchurch, you can still use the services of Christchurch City Libraries – as a non-city member.

It's free to become a non-city member but there will be charges for borrowing items. You have two options.

· Pay per item you borrow

Adult non-city members (over 19) \$2 per item. There is generally no charge for Youth non-city members (under 19).* Please ask library staff.

 Pay a subscription and enjoy the same borrowing rights as city members

Annual subscription \$100 Six-monthly subscription \$50

These charges are in addition to any standard charges for adult CDs, tapes, CD-ROMs, interloans and items from the Bestseller Collection. The same extended loan charges apply as general membership.

If you have a library card from another public library in New Zealand, you may have free access to Christchurch City Library during your stay in Christchurch. There is a limit of 2 items and some conditions apply.

*Youth from Hurunui, Selwyn, Banks Peninsula and Waimakariri Districts are able to borrow items free of charge, This will be reviewed in 2006.

YOUR CARD

Your card is like a credit card so please take care of it and don't lend it to anyone else. If your card is lost or stolen, please let us know immediately. You will be liable for any items that are borrowed before the loss is reported. There will also be a charge for a replacement card.

Replacement card charges

• Adults \$5 • Youth \$2

All items borrowed on your card are your responsibility - you will be asked to pay for any losses or damage. If your debt remains unpaid, it will be lodged with a collection agency.

YOUR ACCOUNT

You can access your library record online with a Personal Identification Number (PIN). Not only can you find out what you have on loan and when it's due back but you can place reserves and check which titles you have already requested. You can also access specialist databases. Most importantly, your account can be accessed wherever you are; at home, at work or at the library.

To get a PIN, please ask a librarian.

If you have an email address that you check regularly, we can email your library notices.

BORROWING INFORMATION

You can have up to 20 items out on loan, once your address has been verified.

Most items can be borrowed for 28 days. If you want to keep an item longer there will be a charge payable when you return the item. We will send you a reminder when the item is two weeks overdue.
