

Conditions Of Membership as at 1 October 2010

1. You are responsible for items borrowed with your card. This includes any items borrowed by other people using the card.
2. Most items can be borrowed for 28 days. Beyond that, overdue fines will be payable when the item is returned.
3. You will be unable to borrow if you:
 - don't return items within 27 days of their due date;
 - have unpaid fines or debts totalling \$15.30 or more;
 - have not paid fines or debts that have been outstanding for over a month.
4. You must notify Christchurch City Libraries immediately your card is lost or stolen. You are responsible for items borrowed with the card until the time of notification.
5. To apply for Membership you must supply the following forms of identification:
 - proof of identity (passport or two other forms of identification with one preferably being a photo ID);
 - proof of address (power account, telephone account, or bank statement no more than 30 days old).
6. If you are under 16 years of age at the time of joining, a parent or legal guardian must also sign your Application for Membership. Any communication regarding your membership will be with your parent or legal guardian who, by signing your Application, agrees to be responsible for the use of your card, including any outstanding fines and debts incurred by you.
7. Christchurch City Libraries is not responsible for the choice of items borrowed with your card.
8. These Conditions of Membership may change. The revised Conditions will be displayed on the Library website. You are deemed to have had notice of such changes and agreed to be bound by the amended Conditions whilst you are a member.

Privacy Statement

1. By completing an Application for Membership you are providing personal information about you to Christchurch City Libraries (a unit of the Christchurch City Council). You agree that Christchurch City Libraries may use that information for the purpose of:
 - managing your membership, including maintaining your records, advising you of overdue items, recovering outstanding fines and debts, advising you of library services and events and contacting your nominated contact person;
 - if you are under 16 years of age, discussing with your parent or legal guardian any matters arising from your membership of Christchurch City Libraries.
2. The information may be given to appropriate Council staff and/or a credit agency in the event of Christchurch City Libraries deciding to take action against you for the recovery of outstanding fines and debts.
3. You agree that you may be contacted by post, email and telephone (including automated telephone messages and text messages) and that Christchurch City Libraries will not be responsible for third parties accessing any mail, email or telephone messages sent to you.
4. Personal information about you will be held by Christchurch City Libraries. You may have access to that information and request changes to it.
5. You are not required by law to provide personal information. However, if you do not supply the information requested on the Application for Membership, then Christchurch City Libraries may be unable to process your application.

Non-City Membership

If you live outside the Christchurch City Council area or are visiting Christchurch you can become a Non-City Member. It's free to join, but there are charges for borrowing items.

Non-City members aged 19 and over have two options:

- pay per item you borrow: \$3.10 per item
- pay a subscription and enjoy the same borrowing privileges as a Christchurch City Council area member:
 - Annual subscription: \$102.20
 - Six-monthly subscription: \$51.10

These charges are in addition to any standard charges for CDs, DVDs, talking books and tapes from the Adult Collection, inter-library loans and Bestsellers. The same overdue fines apply as for general membership. Non-city youth members from Hurunui, Selwyn and Waimakariri Districts are able to borrow items free of charge. This may be reviewed.

Visitors

You have free access to Christchurch City Libraries during your stay in Christchurch if you have brought your current library card from another public library in New Zealand. There is a limit of two items and some conditions apply.

Your Card

All items borrowed on your card are your responsibility – you will be asked to pay for any losses or damage. If your debt remains unpaid, it will be lodged with a collection agency.

Replacement card charges are:

- Adults \$5.10
- Youth \$2
- Concession \$2

Remember

- Bring your library card whenever you visit the library
- Tell us when you change your address
- Phone us immediately if your card is lost or stolen
- You are responsible for any items that are borrowed before the loss is reported.

Your Account

You can access your library account online, any time with a password or Personal Identification Number (PIN). You can find out what you have on loan, when it's due back, place holds and check which titles you are already waiting for. A PIN also gives you free access to the large collection of online resources that Christchurch City Libraries subscribes to – The Source.

If you have an email address that you check regularly, we can email your library notices.

Borrowing Information and Fines

Once your address has been verified, you can have up to 30 items out on loan.

If you want to keep an item past the due date there will be a charge payable when you return the item. We will send you a reminder when the item is overdue.

Overdue fines per item:

50 cents per day (max \$15.30)

You will not be able to borrow if you:

- don't return items within 27 days of their due date
- have unpaid fines or debts totalling \$15.30 or more
- have not paid fines or debts that have been outstanding for over a month.

Loan Periods and Charges

Most items in the library are free to borrow and are issued for 28 days, however there are some exceptions. These include:

Magazines

14 day loan

Bestseller Collection

7 day loan \$5.10

General DVDs

7 day loan singles \$1

7 day loan sets \$2

CDs, Tapes, Talking Books, Language courses on CD

28 day loan singles \$1

28 day loan sets \$2

Catalogue

The library catalogue gives information on all the items we hold in the library. You can access the catalogue in any of our libraries or on our website: christchurchcitylibraries.com

Use the catalogue to check:

- if we hold a particular title
 - where it is located in the library network
 - whether it is available to borrow.

Placing Holds on Items

You can place a hold on an item for only \$2. It's easy.

You can use the online catalogue to place a hold and choose which library to collect it from. You will need a password or PIN to do this. Alternatively, you can simply ask a librarian or give us a call. You will receive an email or letter when the item is ready to collect.

Inter-Library Loans

If the library does not have an item you want, please ask us about inter-library loan – a co-operative scheme where libraries throughout New Zealand lend items to each other. There is a charge for this service.

How do I join?

To join, fill in the attached application and take it to any library along with:

- proof of identity (your passport or two other forms of identification - one preferably a photo ID), and
- proof of address no more than 30 days old (power or telephone account or bank statement).

If you don't have proof of address, you can still join the library – but you will be able to borrow only two items at any time. Provide proof of address within three months to complete your application and gain full membership privileges - up to 30 items out on loan.

Other types of membership

Youth Membership – for those under 19

Children and high school students have their own collections to borrow from. Holds, normally \$2, are free of charge. There are no fines if you return things late – except Bestsellers. There are charges for borrowing Bestsellers, CDs, DVDs, talking books and tapes from the Adult Collection.

ThePulse.org.nz caters for specific high school information needs, and there are several specialised homework and research materials available in The Source.

Concession Membership

You may be able to join as a concession member if you are a Christchurch City Council resident or ratepayer and have a condition that restricts your use of the library. A medical certificate, letter from your specialist or other verification of your condition may be required.

Concession members can:

- borrow books, magazines, talking books, DVDs, tapes and CDs free of charge
- borrow most items for up to six weeks
- place holds on items free of charge
- return items late without fines (except for fines on Bestsellers).

You will still pay to borrow items from the Bestseller Collection and through our inter-library loan service.
