





# The Canterbury Pilgrims' Association

---

The qualifications for Membership are as follows:—

**Foundation Member:**

Any person who arrived in Canterbury prior to the 1st of January, 1854, or the child or grandchild of same.

**Ordinary Member:**

Any person who arrived in Canterbury prior to the 1st of January, 1871, or the child or grandchild of same or the husband or wife of any of the above.

**Associate Member:**

Any person who undertakes to actively promote the objects of the Association.

**Life Member:**

Any person who subscribes the sum of Five Guineas or more towards the funds of the Association.

**Annual Subscription:**

For Foundation Members, Ordinary Members and Associate Members—Five Shillings.
