I think we are leaving on Thursday. The rumour may be wrong again, but I think it is definite this time. At any rate we set out into the country yesterday with three days' rations, but were suddenly recalled last night. We are getting leave tomorrow from one till ten, so it must be right. ~~We~~ I will see you tomorrow, no doubt - perhaps for the last time.

We have just come in from Sheffield by train, and have to pitch some tents and get supper. Good-bye till tomorrow.
